He loved to shop and travel. He had 2 jobs that he loved. AT & T and The Lumiere. He joined the church with me and gave his

life to Christ in his early 40's. he was baptized and reared in the word of God by Pastor Leslie and Gwendelyn Declue. He worked security at our church faithfully until his health began to fail. He was and is a good man and like many of you, we loved him.
